**14** Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ The company paid monthly common distributions during 2017. Please see attached for detailed dates.

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**15** Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ The company declared quarterly distributions in the amount of \$0.2900 per share with respect to its Class C Common Stock during 2017. These amounts were paid on a monthly basis at a rate of \$0.096667 per share. 64.2102% of each such distribution would constitute a nontaxable distribution (i.e. return of capital) to the extent of the shareholders' tax basis in the share of common stock with respect to which the distribution was paid. Please see attached for the quarterly distributions and nontaxable cash distributions per share.
